



## **Brickcycle Program**

### **Two options offered thru this program:**

1. Contractor can deliver "clean" brick waste to our facility at 1437 Cunningham Brick Yard Road, Thomasville, N.C.
2. Cunningham Brick Company, Inc. will pick up with our trucks, and return clean brick waste to our facility at 1437 Cunningham Brick Yard Road, Thomasville, N.C.

There is no fee for Option 1.

Fees for Option 2:

- A. Clean brick waste that is put into provided Hoppers loaded onto our truck for return to our facility in conjunction with a delivery of new product to the job site will be at no charge.
- B. A pickup of clean waste brick from the job site without a delivery of new product to the job site will be charged \$3.00 per loaded mile from job site to our facility.
- C. A deposit Fee will be required for each Hopper provided to the job site. Upon completion of the job and the return of the Hopper, undamaged, 50% of the Hopper fee will be returned.

Rules of the Brickcycle Program:

Option 1 - Contractor delivers clean waste brick to our facility by Flat Bed Truck (on Pallets) or by Dump Truck.

Option 2 - Cunningham Brick Company, Inc. will bring back from job site clean waste brick by Flat Bed Truck in Hopper, or by Dump Truck. The Contractor is responsible to load our truck at the job site.

Contractor must notify our Dispatcher at (336) 472-6181 ext. 102 as to:

- i. We pick up or he wishes to deliver.
- ii. Method of pick up or delivery (Flatbed or Dump).
- iii. How many Hoppers and estimated weight of each, how many dump truck loads and estimated weight of each load.

The dispatcher will schedule a date / time for pick up or delivery and will have our Sales Representative inspect the condition of waste brick on the job site prior to pick up / delivery.

Upon arrival at our facility the driver must check In with the Dispatcher, who will then print a ticket of acceptance with the customer name & job name, etc. as well as an estimated tonnage of clean waste brick accepted. The driver will then be directed to our brick recycling facility to be unloaded.



**Waste Brick in Provided Hoppers:**

- a. Must be filled no higher than the sides of the Hopper
- b. Hoppers should not exceed 2500 lbs. total weight
- c. Different colors of waste brick must be in separate Hoppers (Do not blend Gray body brick in the same Hoppers with Red body brick, etc.)
- d. Only brick waste will be accepted (No cmu's, trash, wood, glass, etc.)
- e. Contractor is responsible to load our vehicles at job site unless otherwise agreed to prior to pick up.
- f. If weights are estimated incorrectly, the contractor is responsible for any overweight penalties on Cunningham Brick Company vehicles.

**Bulk Waste Brick:**

- a. Must be clean waste brick only (no cmu's, trash, wood, glass, steel, plastics, etc.)
- b. Contractor is responsible for loading our vehicles at job site.
- c. If weights are estimated incorrectly, the contractor is responsible for any overweight penalties on Cunningham Brick Company vehicles.
- d. Different colors of waste brick must not be co-mingled in piles or in the truck.

It is the responsibility of the Contractor to provide only clean waste brick to our recycle facility under the above terms. Any load delivered to our facility that contains trash (i.e.: cmu's, wood, glass, steel, garbage, etc.) or has co-mingled colors of brick waste will either be returned to the job site at the Contractor's expenses or the Contractor will be charged a flat rate of \$300.00 for our labor to clean the trash from the brick waste.
